



BURSARIES

As a Catholic school our aim is to help children who, under normal circumstances, would not be able to benefit from a Ratcliffe education.

Bursaries are available for up to 80% of a student's School Fee and in exceptional circumstances up to 100%. All awards are subject to parental means testing.

YEAR 7 ENTRY

Bursaries are available to students joining Ratcliffe from maintained schools into Year 7.

YEAR 12 ENTRY

For external students gaining entry into Year 12, we offer Sixth Form Gifted and Talented Bursaries in the following categories:

- **Academic**
- **Sporting**
- **Creative**
 - Music
 - Drama
 - Art & Design

In addition, Leicester based charity, Sir Thomas White, may also provide a 100% bursary (Day Fee only) for one strong academic student joining Ratcliffe College's Sixth Form from the maintained sector and who lives in Leicestershire. Ratcliffe may recommend up to three students per year.

Bursaries are allocated annually, following interview, assessment in any perceived and noteworthy talent, and a formal application for bursarial assistance, which includes parental means testing.

Offers will be made based upon satisfactory performance at GCSE as per the School's criteria for entry into the Sixth Form.

NOTE

- All Bursaries are subject to meeting the School's entry requirements.
- All Bursaries require parental means-tested assessments, and may be reviewed annually.
- Students and their families must be in sympathy with the Catholic ethos of the School.
- Students will be expected to play an active part in the life of the School.
- Application deadline is the last Friday in November.
